- 14.小明爸:来,咱们先喝点儿茶。茜茜啊,你就把这儿当自己家啊,别客气!
- 15.小明婶: 哥, 您放心, 我们家茜茜呀, 跟谁都不客气。
- 16.堂妹: 妈~
- 17.小明妈:小明,你给茜茜和 MIKE 拿点儿水果吃。
- 18. 堂妹: 谢谢, 小明。
- 19.MIKE: 这个梨太大了,我可吃不了。小明,我把梨分一半儿给你吧。
- 20.奶奶: 那可不行, 大过年的, 谁也不能分"梨"啊!
- 21.Mike: 奶奶, 小明挺喜欢吃梨的, 我......小明: 哈哈, MIKE, 这不在于我喜不喜欢吃梨, 而在于"梨"和分离的"离"同音。所以, 奶奶才不让你和我分梨啊。
- 22. 奶奶:对对对,这大过年的多不吉利啊!
- 23. 小明叔叔:哈哈,妈,没事儿,童言无忌,童言无忌。这就叫谐音。过年的时候,大家都尽量说吉利的话,其中大多都和汉字的"谐音"有关。
- 24. 小明爸:对,比如年夜饭要吃鱼,就是希望自己和家人"年年有余"。就是这个"余"字。人们希望自己一年都丰衣足食,到了年底呢还能有一些剩余。
- 25. 茜茜:对了,MIKE,过年我们还要吃"年糕",我们带了......
- 26. MIKE: 这是不是代表"年年高"啊?
- 27. 小明婶: 是啊,这是希望咱们全家人生活会越来越好,日子过得越来越红火!
- 28.Mike: 太有意思了,我要记下来,回去讲给我爸爸妈妈听。
- 29.小明:还有好多呢。等明天守岁的时候我再慢慢告诉你。
- 30.Mike: 守岁? 什么叫守岁?

- 31.小明妈:守岁啊,就是大年三十晚上不睡觉,全家人一起迎接新年啊。
- 32.小明:对,对。我们还吃饺子、放鞭炮呢!
- 33.MIKE: 这么有意思啊,我都等不及啦!

## **Translation**

- 1. Xiao Ming: What's going on? Why hasn't dad picked up Grandma and the others yet!
- 2. Mom: Don't worry. Your dad just called me, they're on their way. Come on, Xiao Ming, MIKE, you guys aren't doing much anyway, help me stick these "happiness" characters on the wall.
- 3. Xiao Ming: Sure!
- 4. Xiao Ming: MIKE, have a look and tell me if it's crooked?
- 5. MIKE: It's not crooked, but you've got the "happiness" character upside down.
- 6. Xiao Ming: MIKE, you're showing how green you are. This is stuck on upside intentionally, to mean "happiness is here", how lucky is that.
- 7. MIKE: Haha, that's interesting. Come on, I want to stick one to mean "happiness is here" too. Hmm, I'll stick it on the window.
- 8. Xiao Ming: They're here, I'll get the door.
- 9. Mom: Mom, Wang Nan, did you have a good trip? Come on in.
- 10. Cousin: Happy new year everyone!
- 11. Mom: Come on inside, it's too cold outside.
- 12. Cousin: Wow, Xiao Ming, what an amazing new house! Do you and MIKE live upstars?
- 13. Xiao Ming: Yes, I'll give you a tour in a minute.
- 14.Xiao Ming's Dad: Come on, let's have some tea first. Qianqian, feel at home here, relax!
- 15.Xiao Ming's Auntie: Brother, don't worry about that, our Qianqian is relaxed everywhere she goes.
- 16.Cousin: Mom~
- 17. Xiao Ming's mom: Xiao Ming, get some fruit for Qianqian and MIKE.
- 18. Cousin: Thanks, Xiao Ming.
- 19.MIKE: This pear's a bit too big for me. Xiao Ming, let me give you half.
- 20. Grandma: That won't do, it's new year, nobody's separating a pear!
- 21. Mike: Grandma, Xiao Ming likes pears, I...
- 22.Xiao Ming: Haha, MIKE, the point is not whether I like pears, but that the word for "pear" sounds like "separation". That's why Grandma won't let you and I split a pear.
- 23. Grandma: That's right, it's so unlucky for new year!
- 24.Xiao Ming's Uncle: Haha, Mom, don't worry about it, kids say the darnedest things. These are homophones. At New Year's, people try to say lucky things, most of it has to do with homophones in Chinese.
- 25.Xiao Ming's Dad: That's right, like having fish for new year's dinner, it's to hope that the family has abundant resources every year. This is the character -- which

- means "remainder". People hope they have enough for the year and some remainder at the end of the year.
- 26.Qianqian: Right, MIKE, we'll also be having "nian gao" or year cake for Chinese new year, ...we brought this...
- 27.MIKE: This means "each year is better than the year before"?
- 28.Xiao Ming's auntie: Yes, it's to wish for improved living for the family!
- 29.Mike: This is so fascinating, I'm going to write it all down and tell my mom and dad later.
- 30.Xiao Ming: There are so many. Wait till the countdown tomorrow and I'll tell you some more.
- 31.Mike: Countdown? What's that?
- 32.Xiao Ming's mom: It's where the whole family stays up on the night of the thirtieth and welcomes in the new year.
  - Xiao Ming: Yes. We also get to eat dumplings and light firecrackers!
